**F**ounded in 1957, the Aircraft Electronics Association (AEA) is an international trade association representing more than 1,300 aviation businesses, including repair stations specializing in maintenance, repair and installation of avionics and electronic systems in general aviation aircraft.

AEA membership also includes instrument facilities, manufacturers of avionics equipment, instrument manufacturers, airframe manufacturers, test equipment manufacturers, major distributors and educational institutions. As a member of the association, these companies have access to technical training, regulatory representation, and a myriad of member benefits and services designed exclusively for their businesses.

Each year, the AEA publishes the *Pilot's Guide to Avionics*, a consumer's directory containing educational articles and timely information about the avionics industry, its products and its people.
